RECIPE

CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIES

Ingredients:-

75g (2.5oz) Margarine
75g (2.5oz) Granulated suger
75g (2.5oz) Soft brown suger
Few drops of vanilla essence
1 Egg Beaten
175g (6oz) Self-raising flour
Pinch of salt
75g (2.5oz) Chocolate Chips

Method

1. Set oven to 180C or (350F)
2. Cream margarine and Sugars. Beat in Egg and vanilla.
3. Sieve the flour and salt and fold into the creamed mixture. Add the chocolate chips and mix well.
4. Drop spoonfuls of mixture onto a greased baking tin, spacing well apart.
5. Bake for 12 - 15 Minutes (Cool on cooling rack)
6. Serve and Eat!
